# **LEGAL NOTICE**

## WHAT SUBCONTRACTORS & SUPPLIERS NEED TO KNOW ABOUT MECHANICS' LIENS . BOND CLAIMS . PROMPT PAYMENT

If efforts to collect from a Contractor or Owner are unsuccessful, there are other means, provided action is timely.

#### <u>Mechanics' Liens</u> <u>Suit against Property and Owner</u>

- Contract is not directly with Owner
- <u>Notice Deadline: 120 Days</u> after completion of work or supplying the last of materials.
- <u>Suit Deadline: 180 Days</u> after completion of work or supplying the last of materials.

#### <u>Miller Act</u> <u>Suit on Federal Surety Bond</u>

- Federal Contract
- <u>Notice Deadline: 90 Days</u> Notice to General Contractor if there is no contract with Prime Contractor after completion of work or supplying the last of materials.
- <u>Suit Deadline: 1 Year from Work</u> after completion of work or supplying the last of materials.

#### Little Miller Act Suit on State Surety Bond

- State Contract
- <u>Notice Deadline: 90 Days</u> Notice to Owner and Surety if there is no contract with Prime Contractor after completion of work or supplying the last of materials.
- <u>Suit Deadline: 1 Year from Substantial</u> <u>Completion</u> after one year of public body's acceptance of the contract.

### Prompt Payment

#### **Private Contracts**

#### Prime Contract

- Prime Contractor must be paid thirty (30) days after occupancy permit or owner possession, whichever comes first.
- If a payment date is specified in the contract, payment must be made within seven (7) days after that date.

#### Subcontract

 Subcontractor or Supplier must be paid within seven (7) days of Contractor's receipt of Owner's payment for Subcontractor's or Supplier's Work.

#### **State Contracts**

 Subcontractor must be paid undisputed amounts due within ten (10) days from date the Prime Contractor receives a progress or final payment from the State.

#### Federal Contracts

- Contractors must be paid within fourteen (14) days of receipt of invoices.
- Retainage must be paid within thirty (30) says after final acceptance, unless contract states otherwise.
